

Adult Drug Court Criteria



LEGAL AND CLINICAL CRITERIA TO BE MET FOR CONSIDERATION

- Non-violent offenders**
- Case-by-Case Determination**
Those with drug trafficking history
- Chemical substance dependent**
A chemical substance dependency diagnosis is required
- Excluded**
If severe mental illness or medical condition makes completion unlikely

If developmental capacity prevents completion of program
- Resident of Belmont County**
- Clients actively suicidal, homicidal, or delusional** will not be admitted until those conditions have been assessed by a certified mental health professional as being adequately controlled by medication and/or mental health treatment
- Residents of Harrison or Monroe Counties** will be considered on individual basis
- Voluntarily Commitment**

ELIGIBILITY

- The Belmont County Common Pleas Adult Drug Court is a voluntary program**
- The adult drug court judge determines program admission, in-conference with prosecutor**
- Legal and Clinical Criteria is required for program eligibility**
